MAGI's next Clinical Trial Agreements, Budgets & Regulatory Conference will be in Las Vegas on October 12-15, 2008. Our May conference in Arlington, VA attracted over 400 participants, up 40% from last year. 60% of attendees rated the conference "excellent."

The new regulatory track got off to a good start and will expand in Las Vegas. Regulatory compliance is essential, but we also have to get the work done.
