

Spotlight on Research: Questionnaires, Scales and Assessments

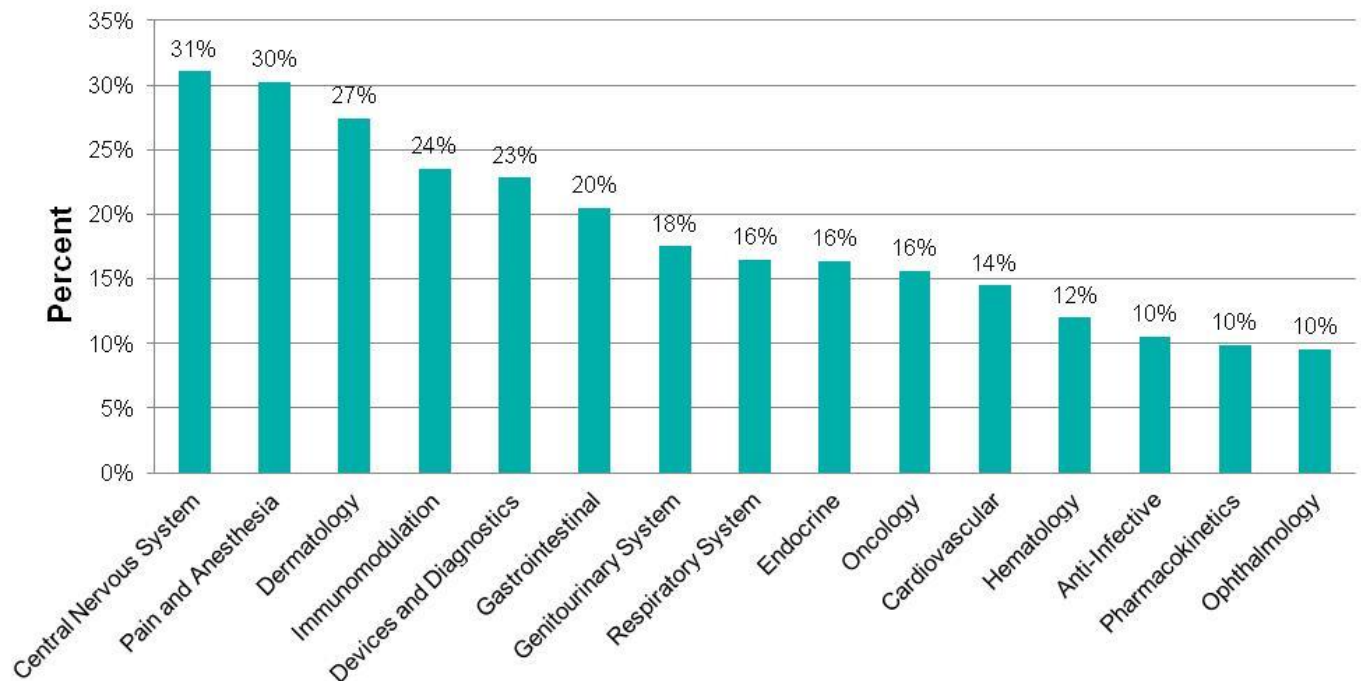
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This column focuses on the percentage of study procedures that consist of questionnaires, scales and assessments during the time period of 2009-2013.

Central Nervous System, Pain and Anesthesia, and Dermatology trials include the highest percentages of questionnaires, scales and assessments: 31%, 30% and 27%, respectively. Ophthalmology, Pharmacokinetics and Anti-Infective trials include the lowest number, all three at 10%
